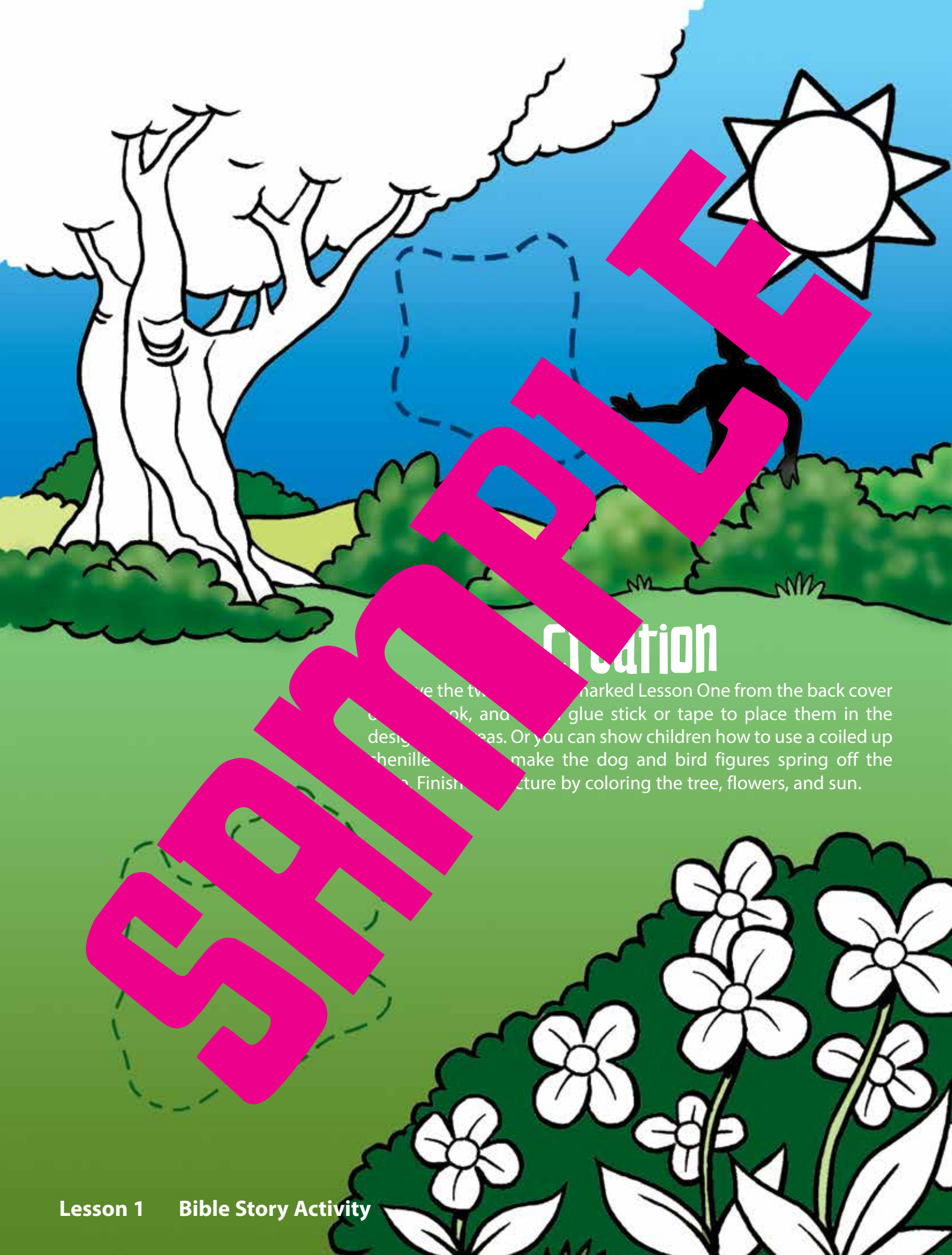
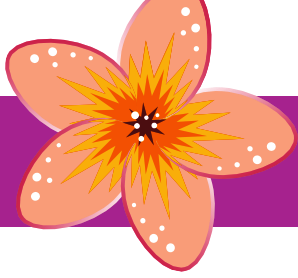




Creation

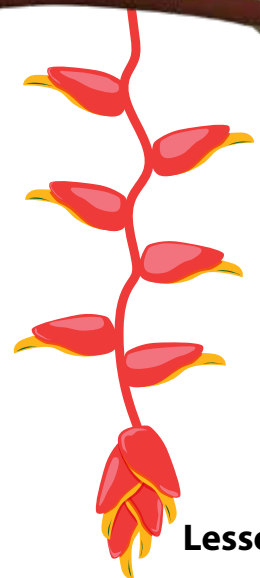

Dear Parent

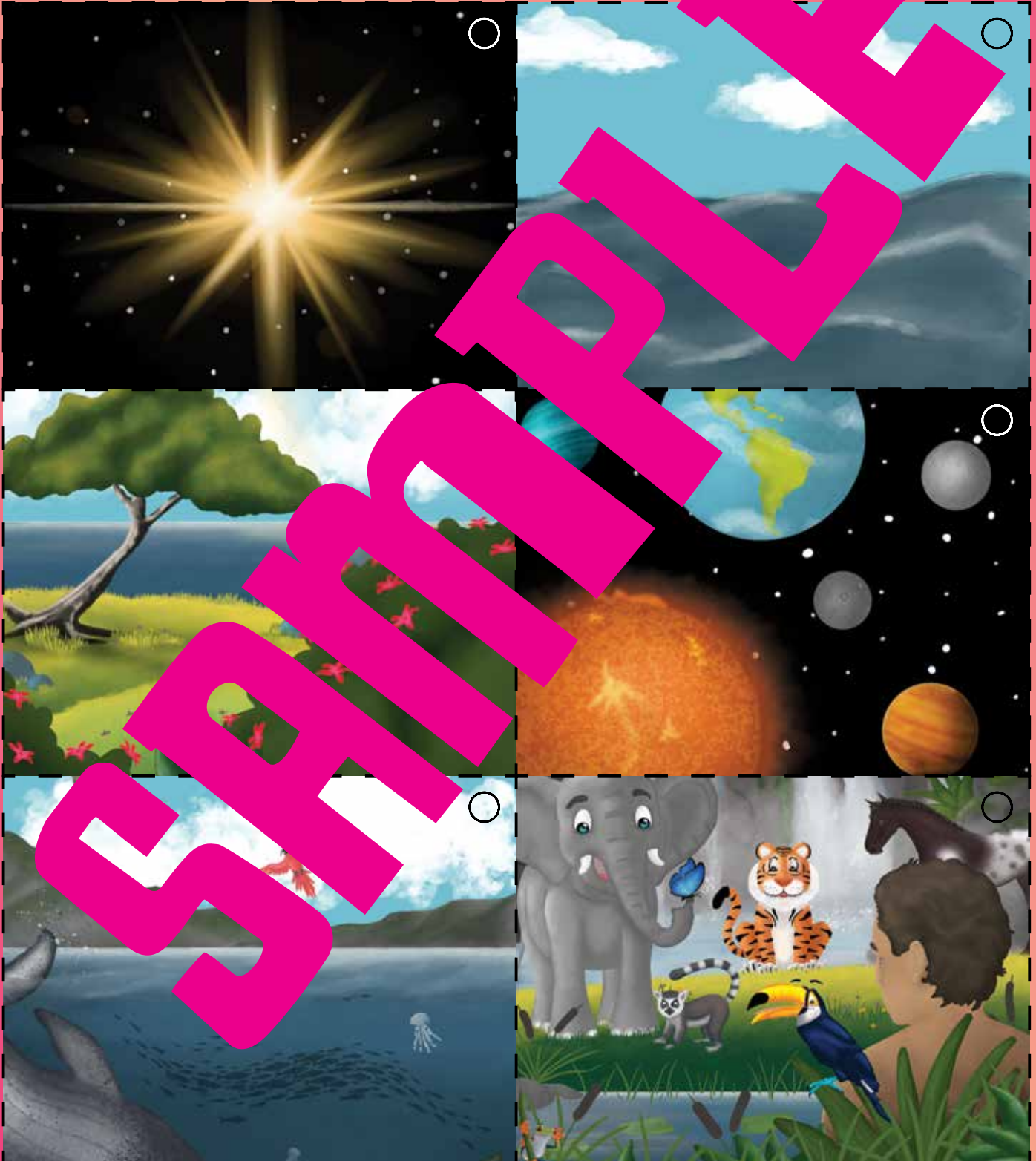
